
## Scene Sizg-up



- Is there any danger to patrollers on scene?, such as blizzard conditions
  Steep terrain (Widow-maker, Cliffs Cliff, 4, 3, Spruce run / Pallisades cliff, Mountain view headwall of lower 4)
  Avalanche, (at big tupper?)
  Flooding.
- -Traffic (cats, skiiers, snowboarders, Sir-rides-alot)
- Live wires (trails 1 and 2) lighting stikes.
- Hazzard chemicals, fumes
- -Structural colapses (light towers, snowmaking Building on trail 1) mid-way jswamid (hair 1)
- -falling from an insecure location (skiiers left side of wraparound, cliffs cliff, 3, 4, widow-maker skiiers left on some sides of lift line)
- Dangerous annimals in the area (humpback whales, big cats, coy dogs)
- -# of patients
- -will you have difficulty reaching the patients (same trails for falling from an insecure location)
  Can you reach them with emrgency care equipment? can you get to them with a backboard or sled?
- will you need to untangle them (ropes, trees)

- -is additional help needed? (channel 2, Channel 1 for amblulance)
- -what has probably occured? does the patient have an injury or illness? what is the probable mech. of injury?
- Is the patient responsive or possibly unresponsive? (A.V.P.U.)
- -Is the patient breathing? Talking? (A.V.P.U.)
- -Is there obvious bleeding)is the general impression poor? (does the subject appear to be critically injured or ill?)

(MOI/NOI)

- -Body substance isolation
- scene safety
- -determine # of patients
- -Request additional assistance
- -Consider C-spine immobileization

(A.V.P.U.)

- -Alert
- -verbal
- -pain
- -unresponsive
